The Mandate at a Glance



What

GMS is PNG's digital tax compliance and sales monitoring initiative.

The Deadline

The official Go-live date for mandatory implementation.



The Scope

Implementation applies to all taxpayers, vendors, and businesses operating in PNG.

The Goal

To ensure taxes like GST are reported accurately and transparently through accredited digital systems.



Why PNG Needs the System

The Problem: The Tax Gap



PNG experiences a substantial tax gap where collected taxes fall far below actual economic activity.

The Global Solution: Fiscalization



- Proven global movement toward accredited digital systems.
- Significant increase in GST collection within 2–3 years (e.g. Belgium & Fiji).
- Increases revenue without raising tax rates.

Defining the GMS

Roboto: An electronic, real-time monitoring platform

1. Digital Recording



Every sales transaction is recorded digitally

2. Correct Calculation



GST is calculated and reported correctly automatically

3. Validation



Businesses issue fiscal receipts validated by the system

4. Prevention

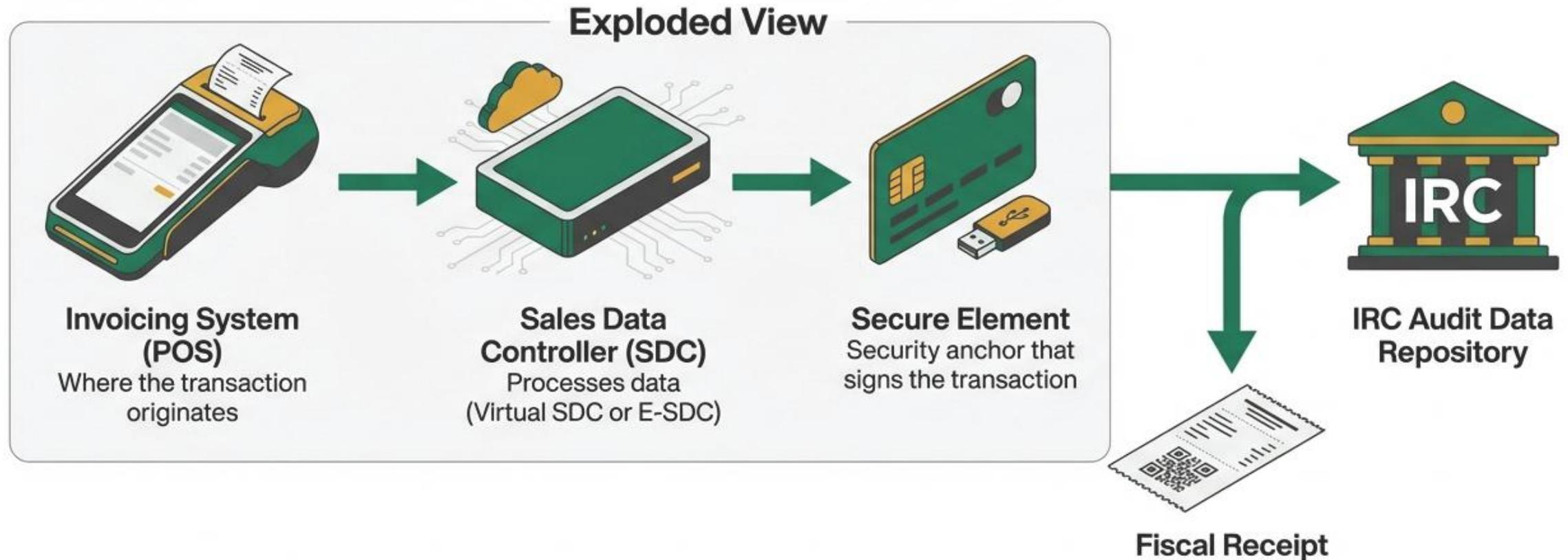


Real-time transmission prevents manipulation via phantomware

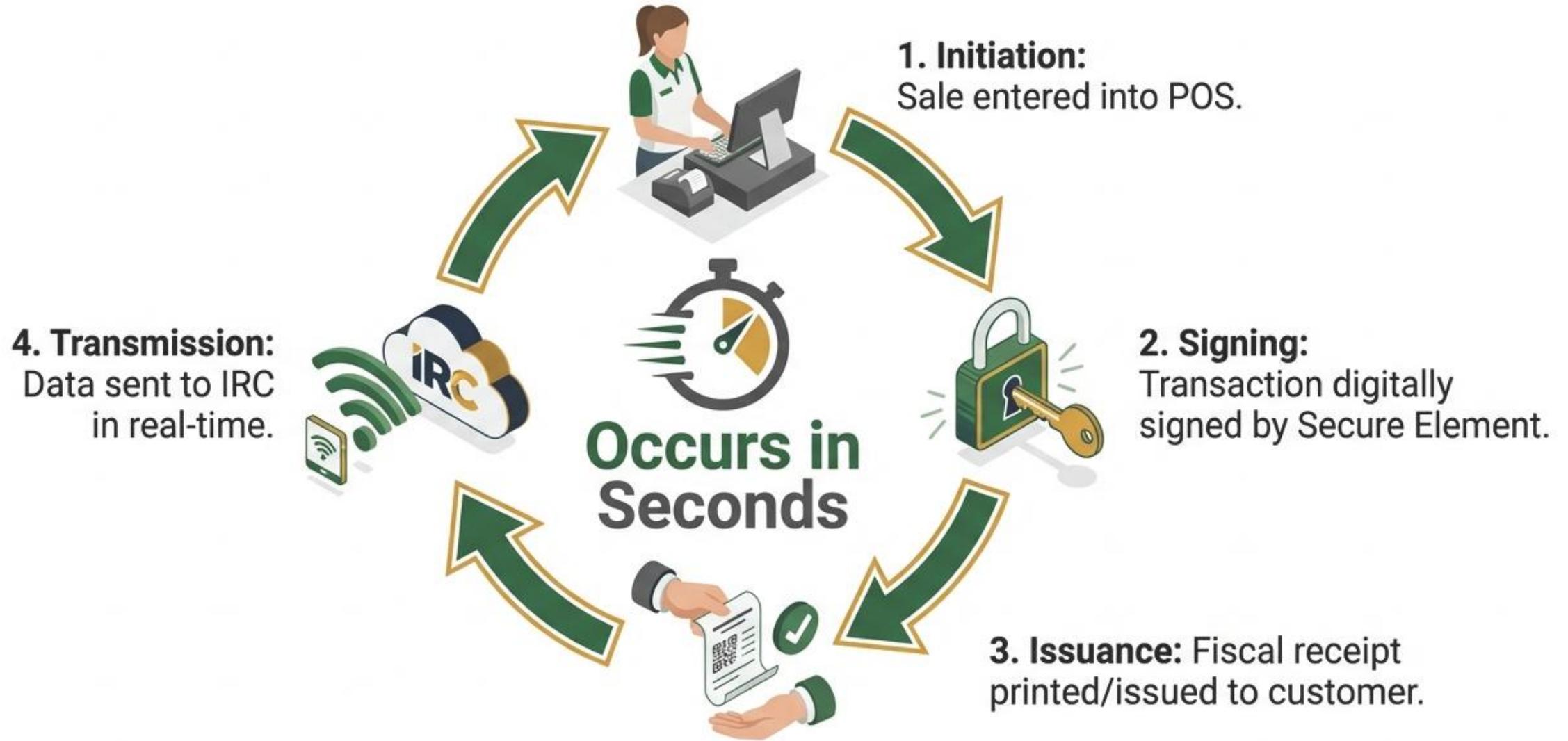

The Technical Architecture: Electronic Fiscal Device (EFD)



The Transaction Flow



Ensures transparency without disrupting the speed of service.

Taxpayer Readiness Phase 1: Data & Registration



Update Details

Ensure business contact information and authorised personnel details are current with the IRC.



Communication Channel

Maintain an active email address for all official correspondence and login credentials.



Registration

Prepare to register into the system immediately once official registration opens.

Taxpayer Readiness Phase 2: Hardware Compliance

Requirement: You must have an accredited Electronic Fiscal Device (EFD).

Upgrade Existing



Modify current POS to meet technical accreditation standards

Purchase New



Buy a new accredited POS/EFD from the approved vendor list.

Free POS Option



Use the IRC-provided free POS (Ideal for smaller operators)

Accreditation is mandatory to ensure the system is secure, reliable, and legally compliant.

Access & Security



Receive login for GMS Taxpayer Administration Portal (GMS TAP).
Set up 2FA.

Request Secure Element

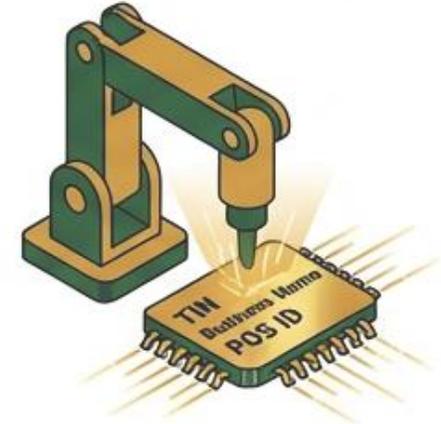

Choose Smart Card (Offline/Online)

Personalisation



IRC embeds your TIN, Location Name, and Unique ID of your secure element into the device.



STATUS: FULLY COMPLIANT.

Authorised to issue fiscal receipts.

Vendor Obligations & Preparation

For POS Providers, Software Developers, and Resellers



Mandatory Accreditation

Accreditation is required before any POS or E-SDC can be used in the GMS.



Testing Environment

Use the Developer Portal / Sandbox in GMS TAP to test and submit products.



Customer Support

Provide ongoing support to taxpayers during the onboarding process.

Understanding Accreditation Types

Transferable Accreditation



Target: Developers, Manufacturers, Resellers.
Accredits a POS/E-SDC version for mass sale
to any taxpayer in PNG.

Non-Transferable Accreditation



Target: Specific Taxpayers with custom needs.
Accredits a solution for **exclusive own use.**
Cannot be sold or lent.

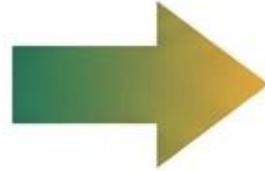
Every version update must undergo accreditation before release.

The Accreditation Lifecycle

Technical Review



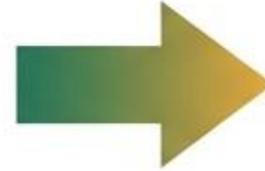
Conducted once per product/version. Must pass to proceed.



Administrative Review



Required separately for each jurisdiction.



Official Accreditation



Granted only after passing both reviews.

Ensures only secure, compliant systems are in use nationwide.

Benefits for Taxpayers



Fair Competition

No more losing out to competitors who suppress sales or cheat.



Trust

Improved professional image through compliant invoicing.



Reduced Risk

Lower audit risk as data is transparent to IRC.



Efficiency

Faster reconciliation and record-keeping.



Lower Barrier

Access to free POS options provided by IRC.

Increased market demand for compliant POS systems.

Customer Compliance Awards (CCA) – “Ask for a Receipt, Win Rewards”

CCA encourages customers to request GMS-verified receipts to help **improve GST compliance fairly**.

What is CCA?



- A public rewards program that encourages customers to ask for a receipt
- Supports fairness by reducing 'cash sales with no receipt'

3 Steps to Taxpayer Compliance

Update and Register Business Details



Ensure your contact info and authorised personnel details are current with the IRC.

Acquire an Accredited EFD System



Integrate a Point of Sale (POS) system that includes a Sales Data Control.

Enrol via the GMS Portal



Use the GMS Taxpayer Administration Portal (TAP) to set up two-factor authentication.

Why GMS Matters for PNG

Levelling the Business Playing Field



Eliminates unfair competition from businesses using "zappers" or "phantomware" to suppress sales.

Boosted Revenue Without Higher Rates

Increases GST collection by reducing the gray economy rather than raising tax percentages.

Country	Outcome of System Implementation
Belgium	Significant increase in GST collection within 3 years.
Fiji	Significant increase in GST collection within 3 years.
Global Trend	Reduced tax evasion and improved economic planning data.

GMS Implementation: Moving Toward PNG's Digital Tax Future

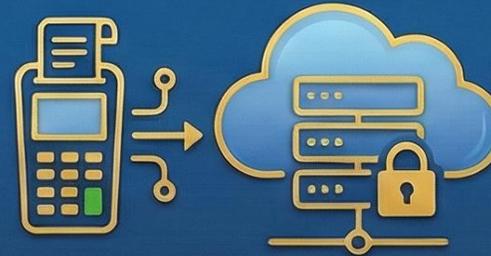
The Internal Revenue Commission (IRC) is implementing the GMS to digitize tax compliance, ensuring real-time transaction recording, reducing tax evasion, and creating a fair business environment for the 2026 launch.

System Overview & Timeline



**Go-Live:
June 1, 2026**

All taxpayers and vendors must be fully prepared and onboarded from this date.



Real-Time Monitoring

Sales data is transmitted instantly to the IRC to prevent transaction manipulation.



Closing the Tax Gap

Modeled after global success to increase revenue without raising tax rates.

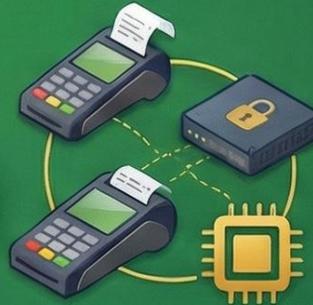

Readiness Checklist



Update & Register

Update business contact details with the IRC to receive portal login credentials.



Accredited EFDs

Businesses must use accredited Electronic Fiscal Devices consisting of POS, SDC, and Secure Elements.



Vendor Accreditation

POS providers must pass technical and administrative reviews before selling solutions in PNG.
